

## **St. Brigid's Boys' School**

### **Catchment Area**

As per the Admissions Policy of St. Brigid's BNS Criterion 3 gives preference to boys of families living in Cabinteely Parish and the traditional catchment area of Foxrock with preference given to older boys by date of birth.

The explanation below and accompanying map outlines these two distinct areas.

#### **Map 1: Cabinteely Parish**

The area of Cabinteely Parish is inside the blue border. Areas outside the blue border (marked in red lines) are **not** in Cabinteely Parish.

#### **Map 2: Traditional Catchment area of Foxrock**

The traditional catchment area of Foxrock is contained inside the black border. Areas outside the black border (marked in red lines) are **not** within the traditional catchment area of Foxrock.

Please note:

- Only one side of the Leopardstown Road lies within the catchment area – the right hand side as you drive towards the Stillorgan Road/N11.
- Only one side of the Stillorgan Road/N11 lies within the catchment area – the left hand side as you drive towards the city centre.
- Only one side of Kill Lane lies within the catchment area – the right hand side as you drive towards Kill-O'-The-Grange.

#### **Applicants who reside outside the Catchment Area:**

Applicants living outside these two designated areas are entitled to apply for a place in St. Brigid's BNS however please note you will be placed in the relevant criterion (as per our Admissions Policy) and may not receive a place.
